Payment

We'll take care of the remaining balance on the day of your tour.

If it's convenient for you, I do prefer cash for the balance - it saves me a few percent and some other fees in credit card processing. If you are in Canada, e-transfer is preferred too.

If you would rather complete your payment with a credit card, that's absolutely fine too. I can charge the balance to the same card you used to pay the deposit, or if you let me know you'd like to use a different card, I'll send you an invoice where you can complete the balance with a card of your choosing.

Aurora tour details

Our aurora chases generally will take us from late in the night through to the early morning to ensure we have the best possibilities of seeing the aurora at her best. You can expect our departure from Yellowknife to fall between 20:30 and 21:30, and usually we can expect our return to town to be between 1am and 02:30am, depending on nightly auroral conditions, the weather, and how far we drive.

When the Northwest Territories is on Daylight Saving Time (MDT/UTC -6) early March through early November, we should expect these times to be about an hour later.

Communication for aurora tours

You can expect that by around 19:00, I'll give you a quick shout via email to let you know what time I'll pick you up from your accommodation for our tour. I prefer to wait to the evening to set our departure time so we can see more clear trends in both the weather and auroral activity.

You don't need to stress about being in touch with me - you'll probably want some sleep/rest sometime through the daytime, so don't worry about always watching your phone for news from me. If it looks like there will be anything out of the ordinary - auroral conditions, extreme weather or otherwise - I'll be in touch with you earlier in the day.

If you have not yet provided me your accommodation, please ensure you do provide me with that *before* your tour day.

You're welcome to text or iMessage me at +1 867-333-0361 if e-mail isn't convenient, but I ask you to please not share my phone number online.

I have put together [a small guide to help with photography](#), and even if you only plan to use your cell phone to take photos of the aurora, please take a few moments to familiarize yourself with your camera's features. It will make both our lives much easier, especially in the winter when temperatures become very cold and fingers very sensitive.
